The ERAIFT's Three-Days Doctoral thematic Seminars in collaboration with its partners from the University of Lisbon (ULISBOA), funded by the DCI-ENV 2020/416-397 action of the European Union

ERAIFT in collaboration with its partners from the University of Lisbon (ULISBOA), organized a three-days seminars from 22 to 24 November 2023, for the capacity building of its doctoral students. This activity is part of the project «Capacity building of biodiversity practitioners, scientists and policy makers for the sustainable management of protected areas and forest ecosystems in Africa», funded by the DCI-ENV 2020/416-397 Action of the European Union.

These seminars, committed to a systemic scientific synergy, was an opportunity for its doctoral students to benefit from a transversal reinforcement on current themes related to their various scientific orientations. The discussions focused on the following themes: Long Term Partnership AU-EU, Biodiversity and Conservation or Plant Genetic Resources, Migration: an adaptive strategy to mixed risks and climate change?, Tropical Ecosystems: sustainable use and conservation, Global environmental governance vs Local challenges: prospects for (re)conciliation, Health Trends, Environment and Pollution – Looking at the Tropics under a One Health lens, Ground)Water resources: challenges from global changes and sustainable development, Agrinatura: The European Alliance on Agricultural Knowledge for Development, Ethics and deontology, Ecological sanitation: full scale experiences in São Tome and Portugal, Miombo Network and relevant research in the Zambezian ecoregion, Biodiversity and Conservation on Islands, Road ecology in tropical regions
