These two researchers will be responsible for (1) supervising the new doctoral students of the ERAIFT-AGRINATURA consortium in the scientific valorisation of the results from their doctoral research through international scientific publications in credible and indexed journals, (2) supporting the "Fundraising" director in mobilising funds, (3) contributing to the visibility of ERAIFT in regional/international scientific activities/conferences.
